Maxthon is often a versatile Web browser that you could tailor to match your web browsing needs. Customization options add some security settings, the interface layout, and useful plugins that you can download being a personal data management tool, decorative skins along with the Google Toolbar. Maxthon is a well thought out web browser that doesn't only offers great performance and it has intuitive interface, but will also, something, what almost every other browser lacks: exceptionally friendly configuration page due to its new users. Of course, Maxthon really has stability issues and some flaws which need attention, particularly if you are looking for UI customization. So, if you are not just a clean UI junkie, don't require a RSS reader and just like a new challenge, provide it with a spin, it's a browser truly worth trying.
